Volume 2, page 125, Vital Records, Stafford Town, Tolland County, Connecticut; married 23 April, 1753, George White and Mary Lansford (Vol 1, page 24, says Mary Lunsford). Mary may have been a daughter of Michael Lansford; he was the only male of that name found in Stafford Town records. The books also show the following marriages:

Lansford, Abigail; m 7 Mar, 1755, Daniel Royce, Jr.

Robert and Jane White, immigrants from England or Ireland, settled in Stafford Town in 1719. George may have been of this family, but I was unable to find a connection.

JOHN WHITE

1:1 John White (George White), b 17 May, 1761, Stafford Town, Tolland County, Connecticut. John was living in Wabash County, Illinois, in 1832, when he applied for a pension for his service in the Revolutionary War. This is a copy of the statement he made at that time concerning his service:

"I am a native of Connecticut. I was born in the Town of Stafford, in the County of Tolland, in the year 1761. I have a record of my age at my place of residence. In 1776, I was substituted for Samuel Turner for the term of six months; was stationed at Grauton, and assisted in building the Fort. The Regiment I belonged to marched to Rhode Island under General Spencer, then returned to Grauton, from thence to Loose (?) Neck and received my discharge from Captain Roberson. In 1778, I enlisted for twelve months, and marched to West Point, and then enlisted the next time for six months, during which time I was taken sick and returned home on a furlough. General Spencer, Captain Roberson, Lieutenant Alcott and Captain Worshman(?) are all the officers that I at present recollect. My residence has been in Connecticut, New York, Massachusetts and Ohio until the last sixteen years which time I have spent in the State of Illinois.....

Sworn to and subscribed the day and year aforesaid:

George W Higgins"

John's petition was allowed, and he received a pension of \$5.00 per month (Pension file number S-32589)

In 1833, John signed another paper connected with his pension claim, in which he stated that it had been more than 45 years since he left Connecticut. He probably went to Massachusetts, and sometime around 1790, was married to Lydia Woodruff. They were in Massachusetts in 1802, but then moved to New York prior to 1804. The obituary of John's daughter Laura says they lived at Lake George, but no record of them has been found there. Lydia died about 1809, and sometime after 1811, John married the Widow Cory. The Widow's given name may have been Sarah, called Sally, and she had four or five Cory children. A Cory descendant, Mrs. Dora Curry, wrote a brief history, "The Cory Family":

"Pheobe Maria Cory and her brother, Alancen W. Cory were born on the Catskill Mountains, New York, where their father was killed by the falling of a burning tree, while fighting a forest fire on the mountains.

Later they lived with their mother near Lake Erie (at the time of the Battle of Lake Erie). In 1816, they came with their mother and step-father to Wabash County, Illinois. Pheobe M. was born 1806 and married Townley Rigg in 1825. Alancon W. lived on a farm, then in Bellmount, Illinois. His children were:

There were other Cory children: Mary, born 1808, Olive, and possibly John.

The White family lived in Ohio for a time, probably at Painesville. In Geauga County, Ohio, Probate records, we find where permission was granted 7 November, 1815, to sell 170 acres in Concord Township (now Lake County) belonging to John Kinsman, deceased, to John White, according to verbal agreement. In the Geauga County Recorders Office; 1816, Vol 6, page 342: John White and wife Sally White conveyed to Uri Seeley 179.59 acres in Concord Township for a consideration of \$1,500.

On 10 May, 1816, at the Vincennes Land Office, Indiana, John White purchased the Northwest quarter of Section 12, Township 1, North of Range 13 West, paying \$2.00 per acre for the 160 acres. He was allowed a "discount" of \$32.00, and paid \$128.00 in cash. He made the final payment 25 January, 1819. The land is about nine miles north of Mt. Carmel, Illinois.

Cory family records say that John's second wife died in 1823. No doubt she was buried on the family farm. Mrs. Ella Luthe, who now lives there, says that she can remember a grave marker that said "Sarah White", but it is gone now.

John married, for the third time, 19 March, 1830, in Knox County, Indiana, Ann E. Crowel, a widow. Ann was born about 1793, in Massachusetts, but her maiden name is not known. The 1850 Census for Wabash County shows three children living with her, presumably grandchildren, as their name was Crowell.

John died 2 September, 1834, and was buried in the family burial plot on his farm. (Wabash County Cemetery Records; Walters) He didn't leave a will, and there was a law-suit over the disposition of his farm. Surviving records list the case as "Samuel White et al vs. William Pixley et al." In 1838, the Court ruled "that said lands are not susceptible of division" and ordered the farm sold at auction. (At the present time, this 160 acres is divided into seven separate parcels) On 13 October, 1839, Anson White bought his father's land for \$500. Apparently the widow, Ann Crowel White, continued to live on the farm, as she appears in that vicinity in the 1850 Census. After Anson sold the land in 1855, Ann bought a property in Friendsville. She sold that property 20 August, 1867, to Ann Eliza Ridgley, and disappeared from the records.

After John White died, someone made a list of the children who survived their father. There were twelve names on this list. I feel certain that John had at least two more children, and am including them in this report. There is no proof as yet concerning these two, but several others remain just a name on the list. If the location of the family in Massachusetts could be determined, birth records might be found for the older children. For others, I can only hope that descendants may be found who will have the information needed to complete this work.

#### Children of John White:

- 2:2 John, Junior. This name was not on the list, so he was not living at the time of his father's death. But it is quite likely that he was the oldest son. Only two records have been found naming him. He purchased 180.17 acres in Edwards County, Illinois, 15 April, 1817. (SW Sec 35, T 1S, R 13W) In 1824, this area became Wabash County. I have been unable to trace the disposition of this farm.

The 1820 Census for Edwards County shows John Jr as a head-of-household. This record indicates that he was born prior to 1794. He was no doubt married, and may have had a family, but other persons were living

in his home, and the children may have been theirs.

2:3 Lydia White (John White 1:1); very little has been found concerning Lydia. She is named in the list of children, and was no doubt the first daughter. Meager records indicate only that she was born between 1790 and 1800. The obituary of her sister Laura states that Lydia was married to Mike Minnis before they came to Indiana in 1815. Mike was Dr Mitchel C Minnis. The first record found of the Minnis family is the 1830 Census.

From the Ingraham-Lollar Souvenir; by Frank M Lollar; 1912:

M. C. Mines settled at about the same time (winter of 1838-39) in the forks of Muddy Creek, near the confluence of Big Muddy and Laws Creek (Clay County, Illinois). Mines bought a little "improvement" of a man by the name of Brock who had settled there sometime before. Mines was a practicing physician....

Lydia and Mike were both still living at the time of the 1850 Census, but they do not appear in it. Mike appears in the 1855 Illinois State Census for Clay County

Clay County records show several land transactions concerning Dr. Minnis, but only one names Lydia:

Book H; page 65: Mitchel C. and Lydia Minis sell, 14 December, 1852, to John W. Levitt for \$65, the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , Sec 20, T4, R8, filed 22 December, 1852; witnesses, Robert Field and Mary E. Taylor.

No cemetery records have been found for Lydia or Dr. Minnis. The estate file for Dr. Minnis contains a bill for \$6.00, dated 27 December, 1854, for "Coffin for wife", indicating that Lydia died near that date.

Dr. Minnis remarried 20 January, 1856, Clay County, to Louisa Jane Stansbury, widow of Elisha Stansbury. Mike died very shortly after that, as shown by the bill for \$7.00, dated 24 February, 1856, for his coffin. He left no will. The widow relinquished her rights as administrator, and Job Pixley, Lydia's nephew, was named. Taxes were paid on 240 acres. Louisa J. Stansbury Minnis died 9 May, 1857, and was buried in the McKinney Cemetery, Sailor Springs, Illinois, beside her first husband.

Some items from a bill for Dr. Minnis' services to James Williams show how charges were made and paid in the 1850s.

From Ingraham-Lollar Souvenir; Chapter on Church of Christ, Ingraham, Illinois:

Brother Elijah Arnold was sick. Dr. Minnis attended him during his sickness. His bill was \$15. Arnold offered him a yoke of steers in payment, but thought the steers worth \$20. The Doctor was not willing to take the steers and pay Arnold the difference. The officers of the Church proposed to have the steers appraised and the Doctor take them at the appraisal, paying Arnold the difference, if any. To this the Doctor would not agree, and the Brethern began taking sides, and general confusion ensued. The Doctor traded the account to another man. The steers were appraised and this other man took them at the appraisal, and thus the matter was settled.

Mitchel C. Minnis served as 1st Sergeant in Captain Arnold's Company, 2nd Regiment, 2nd Brigade, Illinois Mounted Volunteers during the Blackhawk War. He was enrolled 19 June, 1832, at Mt. Carmel, and was mustered out 15 August, 1832 at Fort Dixon. He received 40 acres of Bounty land (Warrant No. 60813) under the Act of Congress of 1850. On 27 August, 1855, he again applied for Bounty land under the Act of 1855. Hezekiah Brant was a witness to the application. Mitchel Minnis died 22 February, 1856; Bounty Land Warrant No. 72611 was issued in his name 8 May, 1856. On 22 August, 1860, Job Pixley made application to have the Warrant reissued to a Minnis daughter, Mary Elizabeth Taylor, she being the only child who was a minor at the time of her father's death. The family Bible was presented to the Court, and the following dates certified:

- 3:20 Book A; page 53: Minnis, Mary to James Taylor, 20 May, 1852. (Mary E. Taylor witnessed a land transaction for Mitchel C. Minnis; Book H; page 65. James Riley Taylor signed 31 May, 1859, for \$200 for a share of the estate of Mitchel C. Minnis.)

2:4 Chauncey White (John White 1:1); This name appears twice in Illinois records

This shows that Chauncey was born between 1794 and 1804. He died between 1820 and 1825.

The Ingraham-Lollar Souvenir, page 11, states, "In 1825, he (Daniel Ingraham) was married to Rebecca White, nee Taylor, a widow with two children, David and Lewis White." In his copy of this booklet, John D. Brant had underlined "David and Lewis White", and had written "cousins of Johnson White Brant", who was his father and the son of Sybil White. From Clay County marriage records:

Rebecca Taylor White Ingraham was born 13 September, 1799, and died 25 February, 1849. She had seven Ingraham children: Dorman, Hannah, Emeline, Amanda M, Arvilah, Amine, Thomas C. After her death Daniel married, 18 April, 1851, Nancy Kenley. Daniel died 12 September, 1866.

MRS. LAURA PIXLEY

An interesting sketch of the Life of a Wabash County Pioneer

To Elder W. R. Couch the REGISTER is indebted for the annexed interesting reminiscences of the life of the late Mrs. Laura Pixley, who recently died at the ad-

vanced age of ninety-five years. The article will be read with absorbing interest by all who were acquainted with the aged lady, and also by all the old residents of Wabash and Edwards Counties:

Laura Pixley, daughter of John White and Lydia, whose maiden name was Woodruff, was born near Boston, Mass., Nov 10, 1799. She moved, when five years old, with her parents to Lake George, N. Y., where she was bereft of her mother when only nine years old. From there she went with her father to Paynesville, Ohio, in which locality her Uncle, James Woodruff, was residing, who also lived to be ninety-five years of age. With him she resided perhaps seven years, or until she came in the year 1815 with her sister Lydia and brother-in-law Mike Minnis, to Indiana, coming down on a family boat and landing on the opposite bank of the Ohio River, from the place where Evansville had been located only the week before. Aunt Laura has related to her daughter, Ellen, that while encamped at this place, she in company with another young lady, came across the Ohio in a conoe to Evansville in which there was but one house, and that a log cabin, in which was living an old gentleman and lady, who stated to her, that the place had been laid out the week before and named Evansville in honor of one Bob, or Robert, Evans. From this place the little company with their goods and supplies were conveyed in wagons to Patoka. In the following year her father came on from Ohio to Barney's Prairie and settled on the farm where Mr. Seybold now lives, which has always been known as the White farm.

Laura came on from Patoka and made her home with her father in the year 1816. In the meantime, Uncle Wm. Pixley had come to make his home with his father who had settled the Younken farm, who built the double log cabin, which was so lately torn down, and dug the wells which have been such everlasting fountains of water on the farm. He, becoming acquainted with Miss Laura, wooed and married her, Dec. 21, 1820. Uncle William and Aunt Laura first built them a house on the corner of his father's farm on the spot of ground where Mr. Q. A. Ballard now has his place of business, and dug the old well which is still to be seen on that lot. Remaining there about one year, he secured the land since known as the Pixley farm, where Aunt Laura continued to reside until about six years ago during which latter time she lived with her daughter Ellen.

Aunt Laura was the mother of twelve children, nine of whom lived to be grown- six boys and three girls- and seven are still living- four sons and three daughters. Five of these boys were soldiers in the great civil war--and John gave his life at Dallas, Georgia. Aunt Laura had twenty-eight grandchildren, fifty-four great-grandchildren, and ten great-great-grandchildren, and had seen all except four of them.

Religiously, her people were Presbyterians, and she herself, was baptized in infancy. The Pixleys, also, in the state of N. Y., were members of the Presbyterian church and had their membership at the old Dothan Meeting house. When the Christian church was organized, the elder Pixley united with that movement. The Scripture says that "no man liveth unto himself, and no man dieth unto himself, and that whether we live or die, we are the Lords."

Aunt Laura was a great reader of the word of God and Paul was her hero, and his epistles were her treasures; and whenever anyone engaged her in conversation in regard to her faith, she spoke of heaven as her home with all the confidence and trustfulness of a child. Her memory was wonderful, and her mind was a treasure filled with precious recollections. She remembered that with the large family of Couch children and others, she attended the first Sunday School in the great state

of Illinois in the locality of the Wabash Presbyterian church, Mr. Stephen Bliss being its honored superintendent. It will be well for us all to be reminded that she seems to be the woman spoken of by Solomon in the latter part of chapter thirty-one of Proverbs, especially when he says: "She layeth her hands to the distaff and her hands hold the spindle. She spreadeth out her hands to the poor. Yes, she reacheth her hands to the needy." In those days when the country was almost a wilderness, and when Vincennes was the nearest trading point, a good neighbor was a great blessing. And no settlement was ever blessed with a better woman and neighbor than the subject of this sketch.

Aunt Laura lived to a good old age, dying August 1, 1895. She was 95 years, 8 months, and 20 days old, being prior to her death, the oldest person living in Wabash County, and one of the oldest in the state. It is doubtful if there is at this time anyone living who had lived longer in Illinois than Mrs. Pixley.

A good woman has gone to her reward.

#### IN MEMORY OF A PIONEER OF WABASH COUNTY

One by one the old inhabitants are leaving us. The time is fast approaching when it will be impossible to find one of those who have endured the hardships of a pioneer life. The last of those whom we have to record among the dead is Wm. Pixley. He died on Thursday, December 7 (1876), his birthday, at the advanced age of eighty-three.

Mr. Pixley was born in Aurora, Cayuga County, N. Y., Dec. 7, 1793, and emigrated to this state in 1816. His father first settled on the farm now owned by Mr. Younken, and was the third family who settled what is now known as Friendsville. On December 21, 1820, he was married to Miss Laura White, and soon after moved upon the farm where he died. He was endowed with intelligence above the average allotted to man, and was possessed of a superior memory to a majority of mankind. Often has the writer of this been entertained by his recitals of early life- and the graphic and entertaining manner in which it was told. He was, with the exception of the last three months, unusually active- both physically and mentally- for a man of his age. He resided on Barney's Prairie for sixty years, and I feel confident that he had not an enemy living, nor could a person be found who would speak ill of him. He raised a large family, most of whom are living, and the loss to them of a Parent is not often more severely felt.

Mr. Pixley was a veteran survivor of the War of 1812 and one of the early settlers in Wabash County."

Family records indicate that Laura and William were married at Friendsville, but there is no record of the marriage in Edwards County.

While residing in the Cincinnati area, William enlisted as a private in Captain Joseph Carpenter's Company of Ohio Militia. He served from 4 September, 1813, to 17 March, 1814. On 3 June, 1871, he applied for a military pension, and it was allowed. On 25 July, 1878, Laura applied for a pension based on William's service, and it was allowed.

2:7 Isaac Anson White (John White 1:1); b 14 Jan, 1802, Massachusetts. Anson moved to New York with his family when very young. He later lived in Ohio, before moving to Illinois with his father in 1816.

Anson was married 24 December, 1825, in Gibson County, Indiana, to Mary Mills. Mary was born 2 May, 1807, at Hollowell, Maine (Family records say Hallowell, Census records, gravestone say Maine), the daughter of James Mills and Rachel Corson (Will filed Gibson Co, Ind, 23 Nov, 1838). Anson and Mary appear in the 1830 Census for Gibson County. They owned a small acreage on the south side of Pond Run, in Patoka Township. On 25 November, 1834, Anson and Mary sold this land to Andrew Makemson, for \$40. Mary's brother, Asa C Mills witnessed the transaction. For some reason, this sale wasn't completed, and 2 September, 1836, Anson and Mary again sold this same land to William Turpin, for \$260.

At about this same time, Anson bought 40 acres in Wabash County, and presumably moved to it, although they don't appear in the 1840 Census. (N $\frac{1}{2}$  W $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 35, T 2N R 13W) Anson bought his father's farm when it was sold at auction in 1839, paying \$500 for it.

On 27 March, 1855, Anson and Mary sold 200 acres of land to Robert Crooks, for \$2,000. This included both the John White farm, and the 40 acres which was bought in 1836. On the family farm, an enclosed area approximately 50 feet square was reserved as a burial ground.

In June of 1855, Anson and all of his family arrived in Montgomery County, Iowa, where they settled in the northeast corner of the County. In the 1856 Census of Iowa, they appear in Washington Township, and their Post Office was Sciola. This census lists Anson as a carpenter. Douglas Township was formed 20 March, 1857, and the 1860 Census shows the Whites living there.

Anson and all his children were involved in numerous real estate transactions, frequently among themselves. But tracing these transfers is quite difficult as they seldom recorded a deed. Anson bought government land in Section 5 of Douglas Township 14 September, 1855, for \$1.25 per acre. In June of 1856, Mary bought 80 acres from Jefferson P Casady, in Section 8. This is where they lived, and it was known for many years as the home place. 20 May, 1857, Anson bought 3 or 4 lots in the town of Frankfort. His will shows that he owned much more land, but it was not recorded.

Anson died 8 April, 1858, and was the first person buried in the old cemetery at the east edge of Grant. Grant was first called Milford, and the original town plat was laid out 29 June, 1858.

Mary was a dressmaker and tailor, and also did weaving. Her son Warrick and his family lived with her after Anson's death. Mary died 27 October, 1872, and was buried beside her husband.

There were two boys named Edmonds who lived with the Whites. They were born in Indiana, and appear with the Whites in the 1856 Census. In Anson's will, he refers to "James Caselbury Edmonds, my adopted son". James was born about 1850. The 1856 Census shows a Jonathan A E, age 3, born in Indiana, living in the J L White household.

Will of Anson White:

Now all men whom it may concern that I, Anson White of Montgomery County and State of Iowa on this day make and cause to be made my last will and testimony working against all former wills made by me. Firstly after all my just Debts is paid and my boddy consigned to the tomb, And after the death of my wife Mary White, I do bequeath to my 5 children the following Property to (viz) To my son John Q White the land he lives on to (viz) West half of the North East Qr and North East Qr of the North West qr of Section Twenty Twp 73, N of R 36, also the following tract of land lying in the County of Montgomery County and SE of Iowa to (viz) in Section 25 SW quarter of the NE quarter Twp 73 N of R 37 And to my son James L White the tract of land he now lives on lying in the County of Montgomery and State of Iowa, to (viz) the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW quarter of NW Quarter of SE of Section 17 and 73 N, R 36 and also SE quarter of the SW quarter in the same Town and Range above mentioned. And also to my third son Samuel W White, my home farm, let it contain more or less and also a tract of land to (viz) the South fraction of the SE quarter of Section 5T 73N, R36 and to my daughter Caroline M Wilson, I bequeath 80 acres and also to my daughter Mary A White 80 acres of land and \$100 in cash and after her mothers death I bequeath all the household and kitchen furniture and her mother's saddle and her weaving materials and one cow and four head of sheep. And now I bequeath to my wife Mary White 4 lots lying in the town of Frankfort, Montgomery County State of Iowa. I also give her all my personal property more or less and after my death I give her full power to sell and make deeds and convey as much of my property as will pay my honest debts and for to support her. It is my will that James Caselbury Edmonds my adopted son should be sent to school till he can read and write and sipher to the single Rule of three and if he lives with my wife if she should live till he is 21 or with my children he shall also have 40 acres of land or fifty dollars in cash paid out of my property by my administrator or Executor which I will choose my wife Mary White and John Q White and give them all power to carry out my will.

This the 14th day of March, 1858.

This will was read in open Court on the first Monday in May, 1858.

2:8 Sybil White (John White 1:1) was born 29 February, 1804. (Brant-White Families by Ellis L Brant) The 1850 Census of Clay County, Illinois states that she was born in New York. She came with her father and family, in 1816, to what is now Wabash County, Illinois. Sybil was married 15 February, 1825, in Warrick County, Indiana, to John Brant, Jr. The Brants spent the first few years of their marriage on a farm in the Barney's Prairie area. They lived in Vincennes, Indiana, for a time, and then moved to Lawrence County, Illinois. Tradition says that John was drowned in the Wabash River in February, 1836, two months before the birth of their fifth son.

Sybil then married John Gardner Sometime prior to 1840, the Gardners moved to Clay County, probably at the same time as the other White children. John Gardner died in November of 1846. Estate papers were filed 2 August, 1847, naming Sybil Gardner and Hezekiah Brant as administrators. David Minnis was an appraiser.

Sybil was married 10 August, 1847, to William Chrisman. (Clay Co. old book No. 1, page 12) William was born in Maryland, about 1797. He was an early Clay County resident, settling at Union Prairie in 1841.

Sybil died 1 March, 1879, and was buried in the Brant-Levitt Cemetery, north-east of Sailor Springs, Clay County. (Brant-White Families) Sybil's grandson, John D. Brant, wrote that she weighed over 300 pounds.

(Cemetery records, Ingraham Cemetery, Ingraham, Illinois) She was born in New York (1850 Census) and came to Illinois with her father in 1816. No record has been found for her marriage to George William Ingraham, b 25 July, 1801, New York, son of Philo Ingraham and Arvilla Barney.

The Ingraham-Lollar Souvenir has quite a lot to say about William. On page 43: "William Ingraham, who was the Bishop of the church for more than 40 years. He labored more, did more toward building up the church and holding it together, than any other one man... .."

From William's biography, page 7: "...came with his parents to Barney's Prairie Illinois, in 1807. In 1838 he came to Clay County..... He and Wm. Read organized the Church of Christ in the Forks of Muddy in 1839, with himself as Elder and Wm. Read as Evangelist."

"They entered zealously into the work of the ministry and in a few years had organized churches at Wolfe Creek (Bogota) and Liberty in Jasper Co, Ramsey and Bishop Point, Effingham Co, Lutes, Brushville, Georgetown and other points."

"In after years Eld. Wm. Ingraham gave up the evangelistic work and gave his entire attention to the church and his farm at Ingraham. He discharged his public duties honestly, sincerely and faithfully, as he saw those duties resting upon him....."

After the death of Mary White Ingraham, William married Mary Utterback. They had one child, Sarah Margaret, who married Lon Webster. An adopted son, Francis M Couster, born about 1839, married a Fisher and moved to Oregon. William died 1 February, 1888, and the second wife died 11 April, 1899. All three are buried in Ingraham Cemetery.

David died 8 November, 1898, and is buried with Dianah and Emily in the Ingraham Cemetery.

David lived in the vicinity of Ingraham, which is in Pixley Township of Clay County. He was a Deacon in the Church of Christ at Ingraham for many years. The 1883 marriage record states that he was "of Jasper County". Descendants still live on the old home place. The Ingraham-Lollar Souvenir has a picture of David on page 54.

3:33 John Quincy White (Anson White 2:7); b 23 April, 1828, Gibson County, Indiana. He moved with his family to Wabash County, Illinois, probably about 1836. Quincy was married 15 January, 1855, in Mt. Carmel, Illinois, to Abigail Amanda Pixley. Family tradition says that they were married at the Tilton House, a hotel in Mt. Carmel.

Amanda was born 24 October, 1835, in Edwards County, Illinois, the daughter of Isaac Pixley and Sarah (Sally) Hazelton. Isaac served in the Black Hawk War, then died young, on 29 March, 1836. Under the Act of Congress, 28 September, 1850, those who had served in the Black Hawk War were entitled to 40 acres of Public Land. On 5 February, 1851, in Wabash County Court, Samuel Hazelton was appointed guardian of Amanda. On 8 February, Samuel appeared in Court to file, on behalf of Amanda, a claim for her father's Bounty Land. William Hazelton appeared on the same day, to present family records attesting to Amanda's birth.

The Ruark family appears immediately following the Warren Hazelton family.

On 27 January, 1855, Quincy and Amanda conveyed 40 acres of land in Wabash County to Samuel Hazelton for \$50. This was the land Amanda had received for her father's military service (Warrant NO. 33,629). On 27 March, 1855, Quincy and Amanda conveyed 40 acres to Robert Crooks, for \$100. (NW $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 35, T2, N, R 13W)

On this same date, 27 March, Amanda appeared in Court and filed for additional Bounty Land, (120 acres) to which she was entitled under a new Act passed by Congress 3 March, 1855. Anson and Mary White appeared with her and testified that Abigail Amanda White was the former Abigail Amanda Pixley.

In June of 1855, Quincy and Amanda moved, with Quincy's family, to Montgomery County, Iowa. They appeared there in Washington Township in the 1856 Census. The first deed recorded for Quincy shows that he bought, 15 October, 1858, 20 acres in Section 20, Douglas Township, from Aaron Patterson. He bought 120 acres of Government land in Section 20 in 1859, and Amanda bought 109.53 acres in 1860. This was by Federal Warrant, (No. 87,204) for her father's military service, and was in Section 2, just east of Milford, now Grant.

Sometime during this early period in Iowa, Quincy made a drop-leaf walnut table. Tradition says that he felled the tree and sawed the lumber for it. It was a large tree; the center section of the table, 22 $\frac{1}{2}$  inches wide, is of one board. The saw marks can still be seen where Quincy made the cuts to fit the leaves. The legs were turned on a hand lathe. No doubt he made other furniture, also, but this is the only known surviving piece.

In 1869, Quincy bought Government land in Lincoln Township, Adams County, and moved his family there. Their Post Office address was Hayes. Quincy enjoyed

hunting and fishing more than he did farming, and sometimes joined an Indian hunting party. The Indians called Quincy "Great White Chief". This probably was due to his height of six feet, four inches. (Mandy was four feet, ten inches tall)

Quincy and Mandy joined the Church of the Brethren at Mt. Etna, commonly called the Dunkard Church. They regularly drove a team and buggy seven miles to church. The Dunkards were plain folk, and men and women both dressed in sober black or brown. The men wore beards. Quincy's hymn book, printed in 1901, contains only words; they didn't use musical instruments.

Quincy and Mandy celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary 15 January, 1905. The following account appeared in the Adams County Free-Press, Corning, Iowa:

"On last Sunday morning the quiet home of one of our Lincoln Township neighbors was invaded by over three score of relatives and friends. The occasion being the Golden Wedding anniversary of Mr and Mrs J Q White of Lincoln Center. As this only comes but once in a life-time, it was a very enjoyable occasion. While some few were busy in the kitchen, preparing the dinner the remainder were quietly enjoying themselves in another room. When finally a hush was put on all merriment, as Rev. Bailey of Mt. Etna stepped forward and with a most feeling and appropriate speech and prayer, presented to Mr. White a \$10.00 gold piece from the neighbors, and a gold headed cane from five children and his only brother, whose initials were engraved on the head. To Mrs. White, a gold lined silver basket, with the inscription, "Mother from Children"; a gold decorated china bread plate, from J. W. Corbin and family, and a delicate gold band glass berry set from a daughter and family of Emporia, Kansas.

The souvenir of the day was a white paper napkin, with a gold lettering, J. Q. White- A. A. Pixley, Mt.Carmel, Ill, 1855; J. Q. White- A.A. White, Hayes, Iowa, 1905.

The names of those present were Rev. Bailey, Thomas Anson White, and five children, J. E. White, wife and five children, Sarepta Wright and three children; R. W. Corbin, Wife and four children; Mr. and Mrs. James Gammell; W. White, wife and son, Rich White and family; Richard White, wife and daughter Vera, the only great-grandchild; Mrs. Wilson and two sons; J. W. Corbin, wife and son; Mr. and Mrs. Westrope and family; R. E. Evans, wife and two children; Mrs C. W. Strait and daughter; Mr. and Mrs. John Ross; Watt Corbin and wife; W. H. Ross and wife; Mr. and Mrs. Houck, and Mr. Flatt.

Ample justice was done the many good things prepared by the ladies and after a very Happy day all departed. Music was furnished by Miss Gladys Corbin of Grant, a granddaughter. May God grant that this couple alone in their old age may enjoy a great many more years of sacred companionship together, before they are called to their reward, is the wish of the writer."

Mandy died 21 November, 1907. Their son John and his family moved in with Quincy, but he disliked the noise and confusion of the children, so he moved into a small shack in the back yard, coming in just for meals. Quincy died 4 July, 1916. He and Mandy are buried at Lincoln Center.

Quincy's obituary, which appeared in the Adams County Free-Press, tells much of pioneer life:

"J. Q. White, one of the old and respected pioneers of the County, passed away July 4th, at the old home place in Lincoln Township. The funeral was held Friday afternoon, July 7, at 2 o'clock, at the Lincoln Center Church, and was conducted by Rev. Homer F. Caskey. Interment was made in the church yard adjoining, beside his wife who died November 21, 1907.

John Quincy White was born April 23, 1828 in Gibson County, Indiana, and was aged 88 years, 2 months and eleven days. He was the oldest son of Anson White and Mary Mills and leaves one brother, S. W. White, the youngest and resides at Red Oak. Mr. White lived in the vicinity of his birth for twenty years, then went to Wabash, Illinois, where he met his wife, Miss Amanda Pixley, to whom he was married January 15, 1855 and came the same spring to Iowa settling in Montgomery County, west of Milford. The trip was made in the prairie schooner, in which all their earthly possessions were packed.

In 1869 they removed to Adams County and obtained raw land, which is now one of the fine homes in the County. The lumber for the house was hauled from Des Moines, and strange to say, after nearly fifty years of sheltering the family, the dwelling is in good condition and is still being used.

Mr. White usually took a better part of a week when he went to mill with his grist, to Council Bluffs, or St. Joe, Missouri, the nearest grist mill and always laid in a good supply, taking his wheat and having it ground, the buckwheat and corn for meal. Upon these journeys the old double-barrel shot gun was a necessary for safety and also served to obtain wild game for food. The old gun is still in the family, and is valued by the children. (After this appeared in the paper, the gun was stolen)

He leaves the following children: I. A. White of Hopp Post, Montana; S. J. White of Bolivar, Missouri; O. A. White, of Curtis, Oklahoma; Mrs. Orrin Wright of Emporia, Kansas; Mrs. Joe Stoll of Lake George, Colorado; Mrs. R. W. Corbin of Grant; Mrs. James Gammell of Corning and J. E. White of Lincoln Township, residing in the old home. He also leaves thirty-four grandchildren and thirty great-grandchildren."

From a letter dated 23 January, 1886, by J. Q. White to daughter Sarepta:  
".....I hope you will not go any further south, for you will find chills and fever and other diseases too numerous to mention, so take my advice, for I know something about South for I lived south of St. Louis in Illinois and Indiana, 28 miles from Evansville, on the Ohio River, and there is diphtheria scarlet fever, mumps, yellow fever, and colery, and all diseases that man is heir to. I would go to Oregon or Washington; they get \$3.00 a day....."

A letter written by Amanda White, while on a trip to Colorado in 1905:  
September the 11

Dear Children,

I will try to rite you a few lines to let you know that we got here all right and found them all well and we are both all right onley bad colds. well i think this is hard looking place you cant see eny thing but hills and rocks i have not seen a good garden sence i came here and no corn that was more than knee high i saw Frankie yesterday i have not saw Joe yet we got here in the night and it was raining to beate the band and so darke that James walked all the way from the train and led the team there is no deapo there so we stoped at Mr. Wickes (?) and staide until it light enough to see we never slep eny from 4 oclock untill we got here one day and a half

and one nite you bet we was tired and sleepy but we did not think mutch about that so we got here all right well, i can't rite mutch now i will tell you all the newes when i see you so rite when you get this and direct to hay-man post the same as you do to the rest when you rite so i will close for this time hopin to hear from you soon.  
from A A and J Q White to emma and James Gammell"

#### White Reunion

"Following an Annual custom for a number of years past, seventy-six relatives of the White family from Montgomery and Adams Counties met in Grove Park last Sunday for their 1931 reunion. The big picnic dinner at noon was a feature of the day, following which the time was spent in visiting, and recalling old times.

Letters received from relatives in Michigan, Colorado, and Winfield, Iowa, who were not able to be present at the reunion. The following were present: Mr. and Mrs Sherman White and three children; Mr. and Mrs A. Boswell; Dorothy White; Mr and Mrs E A White and Granddaughter, Marilyn McCoy; Mr. and Mrs. George White and daughter; Mr. and Mrs. Ernest (White) Long, two sons; Mrs. Bernice Yale and daughter.

Mr. and Mrs. Chester Dotson and two children; Mr. and Mrs. Albert Corbin and three children; Mr. and Mrs. Chester Kingery and Ronald; Mr. and Mrs. O. A. White; Mr. and Mrs. R. W. Corbin; Mrs. Edna Love and daughter Dorothy of Omaha; Mr. and Mrs. E. E. 3:34 James Lewis White (Anson White 2:7); b 23 Dec, 1830, Gibson County, Indiana. He moved with his family to Wabash County, Illinois, about 1836. He was married about 1854 to Judith Price, who was born 15 January, 1832. They came to Montgomery County, Iowa, with the other Whites in 1855. They lived in Washington Township, now Douglas, for a time, then moved into Pilot Grove Township. In the 1870 Census they were back in Douglas again. Like his father and brothers, Lewis was involved in numerous land transactions, equally difficult to trace.

Lewis volunteered 18 October, 1862, for military service in the Civil War, and became a Private in Company E, Sixth Iowa Cavalry. He was discharged 17 October, 1865.

Judith died 25 February, 1874, and was buried in the east cemetery at Grant. Lewis died about 1882 at Audubon, Iowa, and was buried there.

We were somewhat surprised yesterday when Warrick White appeared to us. He has been to the Salt Lake reunion of the Grand Army and for old friendship's sake concluded to make us a visit. Of course we were pleased to see him.....

Warrick bought his brother Quincy's farm when Quincy moved to Adams County, and retained possession of it until his death. He lived there until after Sarah's death; then he went to Red Oak, and lived with his daughters. His sons lived on the farm at different times. Rich was living there at the time of his death, and Sherman was there when it was sold in 1930.

Warrick died 22 February, 1929. He was 93 years of age; he had a long white beard, of which he was very proud. He was buried at Grant, beside his wife.

He worked at brickmaking, and then learned blacksmithing. Hezekiah was in Clay County in 1847, when he served as administrator of the estate of his stepfather, John Gardner.

In June, 1850, Hezekiah married Isabella Dick, and moved to Olney, Illinois, where he operated a blacksmith shop until 1855. He then moved onto a farm in Sonora Township, Hancock County, Illinois, northeast of Hamilton. In 1873, he built a beautiful home of sandstone. Hezekiah was a prosperous and respected farmer, and at his death, left the home farm of 560 acres, plus other land in the area.

Then there is an undated Contract of Agreement between Malinda J. Burton, Jacob Brant, and George Groves, as legal representative of his son Silas W. A paper from the estate file for Silas says that his residence was one and one half miles northeast of Gatewood.

"Elder Brant was a member of the Union Grove branch of the Ingraham Church. He was baptized by William Read and soon thereafter entered the ministry. And by the help of Brother Read, they built up a congregation in the Oaster neighborhood, preaching at the Oaster schoolhouse and Job Pixley's barn. A house of worship was built at Buck Town, on Muddy, and was known as the 'Slab Church'. Elder Brant was the regular minister until his death, a period of 15 years. They had about 50 members, regular officers, and kept the ordinances.

Elder F. M. Lollar preached his funeral in the church and that was the last meeting held in it. The building was destroyed and the members took membership elsewhere.

Johnson joined Company F of 46th Illinois Volunteer Infantry in the early days of the Civil War. He was in action at Fort Donelson, Tennessee, and was wounded at Shiloh. The 46th was discharged 1 February, 1866, after four and one half years of service.

Johnson was married for the second time, 4 March, 1866, Clay County, to "Arady Troughbridge"; the ceremony was performed by Elder Horatio Brant, Johnson's brother. Henriette (1880 Census) "Arraty" Trowbridge was born 23 December, 1839, the daughter of Ebenezer Trowbridge and Lucy Noel. Johnson and Arraty lived on a farm about 1½ miles southwest of Ingraham, Illinois. In the early 1900s they moved into Ingraham. They were both active in the church.
