MESHACH WALKER

And His Family

1. MESHACH WALKER<sup>1</sup>; b 1751; probably New Jersey; d after 13 June, 1827, Ohio; m Deborah \_\_\_\_\_; b ca 1756.

Minutes of the Council of Safety of New Jersey, 1777; printed by John H. Lyon, 1872; page 113: Thursday, Augt. 7; Meshack Walker was brought before the Board and charged upon his own confession of High Treason.

Ordered that the said Meshack Walker be committed to the Gaol at New Ark, whereupon a Warrant of Commitment was made out accordingly.

This is the earliest record found of Meshach Walker. His parentage has not been determined. New Jersey records show a Thomas Walker in the list of Tories whose estates were confiscated, but no connection has been found between the two.

Apparently Meshach didn't like the Newark jail; it took him only three days to decide that he was really a patriotic American, after all.

It isn't known just when Meshach went to Luzerne County, Pennsylvania, but he was residing there, with a family, at the time of the 1790 Census.

National Archives: Know all men by these presents that I Meshech Walker who served in the New Jersey Regiment six years in the revolutionary war and am now resident in the County of Luzerne, state of Pennsylvania, do hereby constitute and appoint Phineas Bradley to be my lawful Attorney for me to ask and demand at the proper board, for a warrant for the land to which I am legally entitled for the aforesaid services, I having served to the end of the war as a corporal and been duly discharged .... this 26th day of September in the year one thousand eight hundred and seven.

Army Land Warrant No. 362 was registered to Meshach 11 November, 1811, and was sent to his agent 27 January, 1812. The 100 acres was located in the US Military District of Ohio, 5-3-3; Lot 18.

1816 Muskingum County, Ohio, Tax List: Meshack Walker

Deed; Muskingum County, Ohio; Book Q, page 278: 12 March, 1818; Mecheck Walker and wife Deborah, both signing by mark, sold for \$325, Lot 18 (100 acres) in the 3rd quarter of Township 3, Range 5 (Monroe Twp) to David Benter (or Bainter).

On 26 May, 1818, Meshach appeared in Muskingum County, Ohio, Court, and made a deposition:

..... for the purpose of receiving a military pension ..... that he enlisted 10 August, 1776 for and during the war ..... he was discharged at the Highlands of York ..... by a printed discharge ..... and that by reason of his reduced circumstances in life he is now in need of assistance from his country for support, being in his 67th year of his age.....

Meshach was allowed a pension of \$8 per month (No. 14.594), commencing 26 May, 1818, but it was discontinued 4 Mar, 1820. I didn't find an explanation of why it was stopped; perhaps it was because he had received bounty land. Generally, a veteran did not receive both.

National Archives pension records: The State of Ohio, Licking County Court of Common Pleas; ..... 4th day of Oct, A. D. 1826 ..... personally appeared .... Meshach Walker, aged seventy-five years, resident in said County of Licking ..... doth on his oath make the following declaration in order to obtain the provisions of the Act of Congress ..... that he served in the Revolutionary War ..... and that he obtained a pension under the Act of 1818 ..... and that I have not now any \_\_\_\_\_ in trust for me any \_\_\_\_\_ securities contracts or debts due to me nor have I any income other than is contained in the Schedule hereto annexed and by me subscribed and that I have not since that time by gift sale or in any manner disposed of my property .... thereof with interest thereby so to diminish it, as to bring myself within the provisions of the Act .....

I have no debts due to me. I owe none of any consequence. I have no family except a wife seventy years of age, who from age and infirmity is unable to contribute to our support.

..... Licking County, Court of Common Pleas; 13th day of June, 1827; ..... Masheack Walker .... doth depose and say in addition to his foregoing declaration that with the aid of this little property and his ..... labour he had been hither to enabled to subsist himself tolerably well, and so long as that was the case he thought himself not entitled under the law to a pension, and therefore did not apply for it

and that this was the only reason he has to state why he did not apply sooner. He further states that he has never since the 18th of March, 1818, disposed of any of his property except what was immediately necessary for his subsistence. And of which it is now not in his power to render any particular account, his property has now gradually been exhausted and he is now very infirm, and unable to procure a subsistence.

There was nothing further to indicate if he did or did not receive the pension. Perhaps he died shortly after making application. A Meshak Walker sold land in Licking County in 1834, but it may have been a younger Meshach; I couldn't find a record of the purchase of the land.

Many early pioneer families are difficult to trace, and the Walkers certainly fall into that category. Census schedules indicate that Meshach had a number of children, but no record has been found naming even one of them. A partial list has been compiled from circumstantial evidence. I feel quite certain of all except Alexander; he may not belong to this family. He was included because of the association of his son, Benjamin, with John Walker.

Alexander lived first in Muskingum County, Ohio, then moved to Licking County, where he settled on a farm in the southwest corner of Hanover Township. He may have returned to Muskingum, as his estate seems to have been probated there, Number 968.

Alexander had two sons and two daughters; only one son has been identified:

The 1870 Census of Lancaster County, Nebraska, says that Massey's father was foreign-born.

In 1820, Jesse lived in Muskingum Township, Muskingum County, Ohio. In the 1830 Census, he appears in Hanover Township, Licking County. Jesse appears in several Licking County records:

24 Aug, 1839; Probate: Estate of Meshach Walker; \$800 bond; James Walker, Administrator; Jesse Walker and Jonathan Sayre, bondsmen.

7 Sept, 1839; Deed Book HH; page 284: Jesse Walker and Massa his wife to Elias Walker, all of Licking Co, 32 acres in Sect. 24, Twp 2, Range 10.

5 Nov, 1841; Deed Book KK; page 581; Mortgage: \$50 by Jesse Walker on 32 acres (R 10, T 2, Sec 24) to Jonathan Davidson. On 6 Dec, 1851, the record shows that full payment had been made on the mortgage.

15 Jan, 1848; Probate: Estate of Richard Davidson, \$700 bond; Andrew Nicholson and Robert Wills, executors, with John Dodson and Jesse Walker as bondsmen.

21 Feb, 1848; Deed Book 51; page 194: Jesse and Massa Walker to William Weekly for \$1,300, the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sect 24, Twp 2, Range 10 "the south part (64 acres) having been conveyed to Wm. Weekley by Jesse Walker", the balance (96 acres) is now conveyed. Jesse signed, Massa signed by mark. The deed record says "the said Jesse walker sold 32 acres of the north end of said quarter five or six years ago to my son Elias Walker and he sold the same to Wm. H. Henderson."

7 Apr, 1848; Deed Book 51; page 214: From William Weakley to Jesse Walker for \$1,300 in hand and promissory notes as follows: \$100 due 1 April, 1848, \$300 due 1 October, 1848, \$318 due 1 Oct, 1850, \$212 due 1 October, 1854, and \$212 due 1 October, 1856, 96 acres in north part of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sect 24, Twp 2, Range 10.

15 Nov, 1856; Deed Book 51; page 214: A mortgage release is recorded by Elias Walker as administrator of the estate of Jesse Walker.

The deed signed by Jesse 7 April, 1848, is the last record of him found. He apparently died sometime between that date and June, 1849, as his death is not recorded in the 1850 Mortality Schedule for either Licking or Mercer County.

Muskingum County, Ohio, Probate records, Book 1; page 317; No. 3618: John Walker of Jackson Township died 7 May, 1854. In undated Schedule "A" of the estate's assets, in repaid debts, Jesse Walker paid \$45, which was not in the inventory.

Jesse was probably a resident of Licking County at the time of his death, but by the time of the 1850 Census, Massey and the children were living in Mercer County, near Celina. In the mid-1860s, the children left Ohio, and went west. Apparently they didn't all leave at the same time, and it isn't known just when Massey went, or with whom. In 1870, she was living with Elias in Lancaster County, Nebraska, but must have gone later to Fremont County, Iowa, where John and Samuel lived, as she was buried there.

10. ELIAS WALKER<sup>3</sup> (Jesse<sup>2</sup>, Meshach<sup>1</sup>); b 18 Mar, 1818, Muskingum Co, Oh; d 5 Sept, 1888, Lancaster Co, Nebr; m Susan Turl; d 12 Sept, 1888, age 74 years; both Bu Simmons Cemetery, near Saltillo, Grant Precinct, Lancaster Co, Nebr.

Elias probably came west from Ohio in 1864, with his sister Sarah and family. (See Sarah Walker Coate, No. 13) In the 1870 Census, he was living in Saltillo Precinct, Lancaster County, Nebraska.

Taken from obituary of Elias Walker, Nebraska State Journal, 6 Sept, 1888; page 7, column 5: Died September 5, 1888, at his home near Jamaica. One of the oldest residents of Lancaster County, coming here in 1863. At one time postmaster and owner of a stage line, and was one of the prominent men of the territory.

After the death of Elias, his son-in-law, Winfield S. Baker was appointed administrator of the estate.

11. ELIZABETH WALKER<sup>3</sup> (Jesse<sup>2</sup>, Meshach<sup>1</sup>); b 29 Nov, 1823, Ohio; d 29 Apr, 1912, Nebr; m William S. Jeffres; b 10 June, 1824; d 20 Jan, 1885; both bu Scotia, Nebraska. The family name was Jeffries; in William's family, it became Jeffres after they left Ohio.

In the 1870 Census, the Jeffres family appears in Monroe Township, Fremont County, Iowa. Later, they moved to Greeley County, Nebraska, where they spent the remainder of their lives. After William's death, Lizzie lived with her son Elias.

Litta Walker writes, "Once when Aunt Lizzie was visiting in Randolph, the local doctor advised her to have a small cancer removed from her lip. The surgery was performed on Sam Walker's kitchen table."

Florence Brannian wrote, "Aunt Lizzie was crippled in such a way that she bent to almost a right angle when she walked. I recall her visiting at our house and how spry she was getting around out of doors with her cane, completely ignoring her handicap."

JOHN WALKER<sup>3</sup> (Jesse<sup>2</sup>, Meshach<sup>1</sup>); b 14 Dec, 1825, Licking Co, Ohio; d 7 Mar, 1899, Fremont Co, Iowa; m 22 June, 1851, Mercer Co, Ohio (family records) Hannah Adeline Conklin, b 7 Mar, 1834, NY; d 21 Feb, 1896, Fremont Co, Ia; dau of Abraham Conklin and Susan Ludlum. A family story says that John was engaged to a girl who jilted him, and he married Adeline on the rebound.

There is a large monument, bearing the names of John and Adeline, in the Randolph Cemetery, but the record book doesn't show a burial there. Adeline's death record states that she was buried in Orange County, New York.

John lived near Celina, Ohio. In 1865, he left there, and traveled in a covered wagon to Chillicothe, Schuyler County, Missouri. A family tradition says John had \$5000 in gold, and Adeline hid it in a bag of carpet rag balls, then sat on the bag all the way to Missouri.

John was dissatisfied in Missouri, and late in 1868, or early 1869, went to Fremont County, Iowa, where his brother Samuel was living. John and family lived in Sam's granary until they moved into their new home a mile and a half northeast of Randolph. Alice Walker Brannian wrote, "That 280 acre farm was virgin prairie. The purchase price was \$16.25 per acre. The house now there was built in 1881."

Over the years, John acquired a lot of land. He said he didn't want his children to have to work as hard as he had, and gave each of them a farm, except Julia; her husband wasn't a farmer, so they received a house in town and other things.

After Adeline's death, John lived with his daughter Elizabeth Addy. He died of cancer.

The following is taken from a brief history of the Coate family, written by Walter Jefferson Coate, dated 9 December, 1958:

..... Isaac Coate started west from Celina, Ohio, when his son T. J. Coate was nearly 13 years old. The date was May 19th, 1864, and as near as my father remembers, they went through Bluffton, Huntington, Peru, Logansport, Lafayette, Indiana to a point north of Bloomington, Illinois, crossing the Illinois river on a bridge at Peoria. The bridge impressed him at that time as being a big one. From there they went to Burlington, crossing the Mississippi on a ferry. Then on to Ottumwa, Iowa, on the Des Moines river. As there was no bridge at Ottumwa, they went on up the river to Eddyville, about 20 miles, to cross the river. Then through Albia, Chariton, Osceola, and Red Oak, crossing the Missouri at Nebraska City on a ferry about June 29th. Then on down to Nemaha City on the Missouri river, where they arrived a day or two before the big 4th of July celebration. After staying there about a week, they went on to Salt Creek, where Lincoln now stands, but at that time, the location of a small village, called Lancaster. Isaac Coate took a homestead of 160 acres, about 8 miles south of Lancaster, on the Salt Creek bottom though his place didn't take in any of the creek. But before doing any improving on the place, there came up a big Indian scare, and Isaac Coate, in company with other settlers "pulled out" as he didn't care to live in such a place.

Isaac Coate crossed the Missouri river again at Nebraska City and wintered at White Cloud on the West Nishnabotany in Iowa. The following summer he traded for land in N. E. Missouri but returning again to White Cloud in the fall. From there he went again to Salt Creek, Nebraska,

and traded his Missouri land for land on Salt Creek adjoining Grandpa Leland's land.

My father and mother were married at Merridian, Nebraska, August 4, 1872. They went to live with his father, Isaac Coate, and helped him run his country store at Saltillo. After I was born, mother told father that they should have a home of their own. So he secured a homestead in a thinly populated section of Thompson creek, about three and a half miles up the creek from Riverton, Nebraska.

They left the homestead, (I don't know whether it was ever sold or not) and went into partnership with a Mr. Viets, who had a homestead and was running a country grist mill on Thompson creek. We lived there for a number of years, and the mill was run night and day for quite a length of time. I went to the country school in a dugout, and one term in the small town of Riverton, where I lived with the Robinsons.....

Finally, my mother's health turned bad and the entire mill property was traded for a farm with a water mill on it, at Henryville, Lawrence County, Tennessee. After a few years, my father's family moved to Columbia, Tennessee, in order to give us a better education.

I had a nervous breakdown from too much hard study and had to quit school. My father bought an old fashioned water mill near Napier, ..... about ten miles from Henryville, and he made Sam Leland (Mother's brother) a partner in the mill. There were two houses on the property, besides the mill building and I lived in one with grandpa and grandma Leland, and Uncle Sam and family lived in the other. After some little time my mother and grandpa Isaac Coate came to live with me in the other end of the same house I had lived in with the Lelands. It was a log house. Isaac Coate had been living in our home in Columbia some little time before I went to live with Uncle Sam on the doctor's orders.....

It isn't known just when Samuel left Ohio; he may have spent a year in Missouri before coming to Fremont County, Iowa, about 1866. That fall, he bought land on Deer Creek, and lived there in a small log cabin. In the 1880's, he built a comfortable two-story farm house. The building was later moved to another part of the farm, and is now owned by a great-grandson, Louis Frazier. The land where the house first stood is owned by another great-grandson, Jack Fichter. The family relates that Samuel butchered a hog every week to feed the family and guests.

Alpha came to Fremont County with her mother, Elizabeth Pulling, and step-father, Mortimer Nelson, a Civil War veteran. Alpha attended a term at Tabor

College, then taught school; Frank Walker was one of her pupils.

Once when Frank was small, his brother John was ill. Frank wanted Johnny to get well so he gave him a generous dose of horse medicine, which John barely survived. Frank was called "Doc" for years after that.

In 1904, Frank and John, with their families, moved to Holden, Missouri. Doris tells that the children played one afternoon in a box of hay, and later a nest of copperheads was found under the hay. Irene Fite recalled a visit her family made to Holden; she and some cousins plugged all the watermelons in the patch, looking for a ripe one.

In February or March, 1907, Frank and John moved to Elliott, Iowa, and became partners in the Jones-Walker Mercantile Company. The other partner was M. I. Jones, whose wife was a sister of Mrs. John Walker.

Somewhere along the way, Frank worked for a time for the Benshoof brickyard. For years, he was employed by the Petty Seed Corn Company.

Frank and Alpha were both joiners. She, too, took an active part in community life. She held offices in various organizations, including the RNA. The K. P.'s led an active social life, and occasionally, for one of their programs, Alpha composed a song, to be sung to a popular tune. Her daughters then rendered the song at the festivities.

In 1919, the Walker family moved to Omaha, and Frank worked for the street car company for 25 years. After Alpha died, he went to southern California where his daughter Edna lived.

Frank loved horse racing, and made several trips to the Kentucky Derby. On one such occasion, he had his pocket picked. He was embarrassed about it, and didn't mention it to Edna and Frank, thinking that they would pay the



expenses of the trip home. Then he discovered that the Heeneys had lost all their money betting on the wrong horses, and were expecting him to get them home. The hungry group barely made it back to Omaha by using the money Mary Frances had in her purse to buy gas.

When he was past eighty, Frank was in a bookie joint when it was raided, and he spent the night in jail. After that, he lost interest in horses.
